

Math 4L, Introduction to College Mathematics for Business and the Social Sciences Workshop

Course Description: MATH 004L, Introduction to College Mathematics for Business and the Social Sciences Workshop, 1 Unit, Discussion, 1 hour. Prerequisite(s): MATH 004, may be taken concurrently; the Mathematics Department determines the study program pathway based upon the score on the Mathematics Advisory Examination; not open to students in the Bourns College of Engineering or the College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences or to students majoring in Economics or Business Economics; or consent of instructor. Just-in-time lessons and activities to enhance student foundations on functions and properties of functions from four perspectives (verbal, visual, numeric, and symbolic) to complement and support MATH 004. Graded Satisfactory (S) or No Credit (NC).

1. What does my MAE placement mean?

In general, students who receive a placement of "Math 4L" will enroll in Math 004 AND Math 4L, as their first college mathematics course. Math 4L will provide just in time lessons and assistance to support the student in Math 4. Upon completion of Math 4L, your major will determine the next appropriate course for your enrollment. You will continue taking courses until you have completed the mathematics requirements for your major.
