

The School of Education (SOE) strongly encourages all incoming first-years to register for the Mathematics Advisory Exam (MAE) regardless of their expected AP/IB results. Courses in Math, Science, Engineering, Computer Science, Psychology, Neuroscience, Business, Economics, and Health preparation courses will require a specific mathematics level as a prerequisite. If you successfully completed mathematics at a Community College or at a 4-year institution, and it articulates to a UC Riverside mathematics course (Assist.org), then you will not need to register for the Mathematics Advisory Exam (MAE) exam. Please be sure to officially report all AP/IB scores and transfer coursework to UCR Undergraduate Admissions.

We highly encourage new students to finalize their math placement by July 15th, 2022. For students planning to enroll in their first UCR math course this Summer 2022, the July 15th deadline will guarantee meeting the registration deadlines for [Highlander Early Start Academy \(HESA\)](#) or the [ARC 035 summer course](#).
